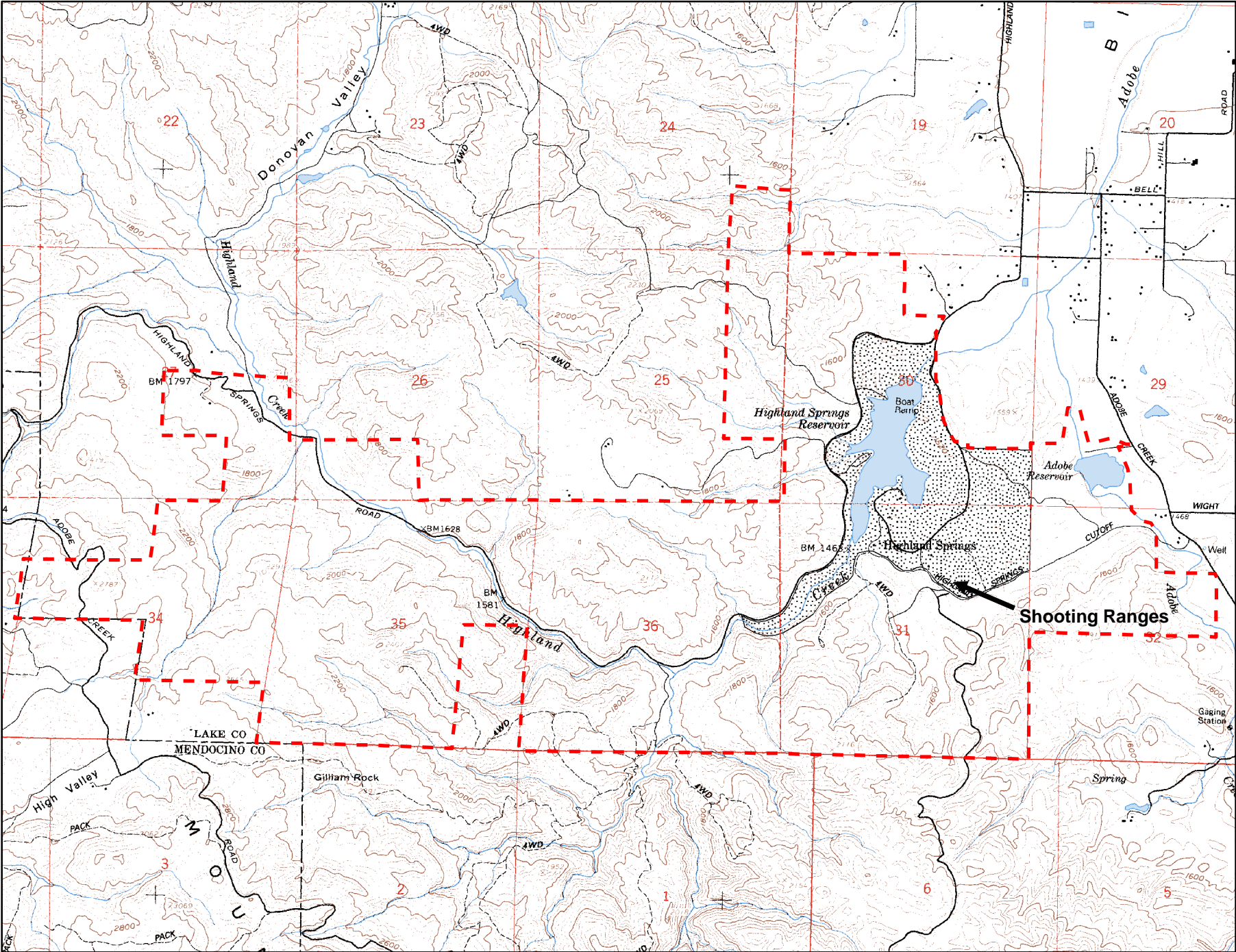
HOLD HARMLESS AGREEMENT

Property is owned and managed by the Lake County Watershed Protection District (WPD).

Discharge of firearms on District property is prohibited unless permission to hunt is approved by the WPD.

Discharge of firearms from any public road is prohibited.

Hunting is prohibited in area depicted on map.

No target shooting is allowed, except on designated / approved ranges with membership.

Letter of permission to hunt on District property must be in your possession at all times.

Highland Springs is open for public use. Be wary of horseback riders, hikers and picnickers.

No OHV use is allowed on District property.

Vehicle use past locked gates is prohibited. Do not block gates and / roads.

Park gates are opened at 6:00 AM and closed at 9:00 PM. No exceptions.
